

What time should I arrive?

Please arrive at **08:00am** to allow time for check-in, a welcome briefing, and preparation before the day begins.

Where do I go upon arrival?

Follow signs to 'The Wing' and into the international paddock and follow signage for **McLaren Reception**. The team will be on hand to assist you.

What should I wear?

Comfortable clothing, closed-toe shoes (no heels, sandals, or flip-flops)

Can I bring a guest?

Yes, you have one guest included as part of your package. Please confirm guest allocation when booking. Guests will have full access to hospitality areas and viewing points.

Will food and refreshments be available?

Yes. A full hospitality offering is available throughout the day, including breakfast, lunch, refreshments, and snacks.

Is photography available?

There will be a photo & video team on site capturing the day and you will receive a link to view the images after the event.

What happens in bad weather?

The track will be open as long as it's safe, In extreme weather, we may modify the schedule, but we'll make every effort to deliver a full experience.



Do you offer any additional extras such as any hotels or dinners?

Yes! We can assist in booking you a hotel the night prior to your driving day at the Hilton Garden Inn located at Silverstone Circuit.

We also host McLaren dinners each night which you can add to your package at an extra cost. Please contact our experiences team for more information.

Will I receive coaching?

Yes. All McLaren experience packages include 1:1 coaching from a McLaren professional driver to help you get the most out of your sessions.

What if I've never driven on track before?

No problem! We cater to all experience levels, from first-time drivers to seasoned racers. Your coach will tailor your session accordingly.

Is there parking available?

Yes. On-site parking is available and clearly signposted. Please follow instructions from event marshals upon arrival.

Can I take passengers on track?

For safety and insurance reasons, only approved instructors may ride as passengers during on-track sessions unless otherwise advised.

Do I need to sign a waiver?

What's the schedule for the day?

The day will be split into road car and race car sessions on track. These have been spread throughout the day to ensure there are rest periods for all programmes to enjoy the McLaren hospitality. For McLaren Experience, you will have three sessions on track with a professional driver coach.

Are there any health or age restrictions?

Participants must hold a full valid driving licence and be in good general health. Please notify us in advance of any medical conditions.

All children under 16 need to be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children under 16 cannot access the pitlane.

Any guests under 25 who wish to drive will need to send a copy of their driving licence as well as their past driving experience to the McLaren Experiences team prior to the event.
